
DIFFICULT TIMES

AWiCS 1st Webinar

It is extremely important that we continue to maintain the connection with our members during this pandemic. Thus on the 26 June 2020, AWICS invited Er Jee Yi Ying, Country Representative AECOM Singapore Pte Ltd to share with our members on her enriching experience in the engineering sector having built up a career spanning more than 22 years. Er Jee gave a webinar for all AWICS members and it was such an insightful talk as the speaker explained the role of infrastructure and its importance in forging resilience, sustainability and liveability in cities.

HER EXPERIENCE

Er Jee shared how her experience in a career spanning from design engineer to now as the country representative for AECOM. She exchanged views on the need for young engineers to be not afraid to ask questions when they get started in their engineering career. One good advice she gave to young engineers is to create opportunity through more robust discussions with their supervisors or experienced engineers who can be their life mentor too. It is through asking questions, ones gained more knowledge and collective ideas as well as past experiences are then shared. Her mantra is that engineers should always have a responsibility to anticipate the changes underway and have a duty to ensure the infrastructure we build today withstands the test of time.

PLANNING & DESIGN

Planning a project is the most importance as a correct footing will almost secure a good delivery. At the same time, Er Jee said one must take to ensure that the right approaches and solutions are used in the design process. She shared the challenges in some of the Thomson East Coast Line project e.g. at Stevens MRT which requires building over another live station with existing constraints. There were existing utilities requiring complex diversion as well as canal and traffic diversion at the Wayang Satu flyover. This is when with her ever sprightly professionalism led her design team to overcome the constraints through robust planning and coordination of the Innovative project. solutions transformed the projects enabling a



successful outcome and delivery of the project.

Er Jee said that the sweet success is when the project is successfully implemented and when the client and agencies are satisfied with the outcome. Teamwork in the engineering industry has been the hallmark of her success as she is able to galvanise her team to have the common goal i.e. deliver the project within timeline and cost.

THE FUTURE LIVEABLE CITIES

As for the future, Er Jee observed that for land scare Singapore, the Government has already embarked on the underground master plan for Singapore. This means going forward, engineers will have more opportunities to challenge themselves to build deeper and safer infrastructure underground. Er Jee is very excited about the future as to her engineering will be at the forefront of infrastructure that will contribute to a more dynamic city that is liveable, sustainable, smart and resilient.

Once again, AWICS thanked Er Jee for her generous sharing and lively exchanges with our members.

The meeting was called to order by our Hon Secretary, Ms. Vimalatulasi followed by a very warm welcome address by the founding president, Er. Emily Tan.


